This was the fourth meeting of the Advisory Committee assembled to provide input into the development of the Hardin County Regional Wastewater Facilities Plan.

1. Introductions

Attendees introduced themselves and cited their interest in the development of the plan.

2. Review minutes and action items from last meeting

Mark Sneve reviewed the minutes prepared from the past meeting including Issue Paper No. 4 – Areas of Concerns and Environmental Considerations. No corrections to the minutes were offered.

3. Issue Paper No. 5 – Existing Infrastructure

Mark Sneve reviewed the content of Issue Paper No. 5. The municipal conveyance and treatment systems were reviewed. The proximity of each area of concern was considered relative to the watershed for each municipal system. The logical municipal entity to serve each area of need was considered as indicated in the table below.

Issue Paper No. 5 – Resolved documents that all municipal treatment plants should be considered to receive county wastewater. Ultimately, each municipal entity will have to determine the ability for their system to accept additional flow.

Initial discussions with Chris Hunsinger (Hardin County Planning & Development) have started. Chris suggested the Glendale and areas north be separated into two areas of need with the highest priority placed on the Glendale Area. This was recommended because of the potential economic development needs.

Strand and HCWD2 will schedule meetings with Hardin County Planning & Development.

All were encouraged to consider planning area boundaries for the next meeting.
